Hello all,

On Tuesday, after an extensive and exhaustive search that included a review by an analyst from the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality, the issue of the gas was resolved. A Heating, Ventilation, and Air-Conditioning Technician from the firm of William E. Walter determined the source of the gas that caused our evacuations and was able to shut it off completely. The technician turned on the exhaust to eliminate any gas that lingered in the building and introduced fresh air. We decided to cancel classes on Wednesday to make certain that these measures satisfactorily closed the matter. We are pleased to report that we remain odor free since Tuesday.

Although our evacuations and closures certainly posed inconvenience to many, the safety of our children and the professionals who serve them take precedence over everything else.
